**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure amends the sunset date for the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors from July 2, 1020 to July 1, 2026.

Agency total expenditures totaled \$2,076,512 in FY-19 and report year-to-date FY-20 expenditures of \$ 1,304,068. Full-time-equivalent employees (FTE) averaged 6.8 in FY-19.

Re-creation of the agency will not result in a fiscal or revenue costs or savings.
