HB 4019 directs the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality to apply to sell its headquarters in downtown Oklahoma City.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure relates to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and their submission for the application of sale of the Department's headquarters and connected appurtenances in downtown Oklahoma City. Once commission of the sale has been approved and assessed at fair market value, funds from the sale shall be deposited into the Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund in accordance with Oklahoma statutes. The DEQ Director will coordinate with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for suitable existing office space to relocate the displaced Department employees. The fiscal impact is dependent on the funds from the building sale.
