**Research Analysis**

HB 4048 cleans up the Oklahoma Sunset Law by repealing several sections of law which contained lists of entities to be sunset in previous years. The lists are now antiquated and need to be removed to provide clarity within the Oklahoma Sunset Law.

The measure repeals Title 74, Section 3903 (entities to sunset in 2012), 3904 (entities to sunset in 2003), 3905 (entities to sunset in 2014), 3906 (entities to sunset in 2015), 3907 (more entities to sunset in 2012) and 3908 (entities to sunset in 2013).

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure clarifies the statutory entities that, if terminated, will have a one year period after the termination date to cease operations. The measure expands the provisions to any statutory entity.

Sections related to obsolete language are repealed.
