Research Analysis

HB 4058 modifies the appointing authority for the five members of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission. Three members would be appointed by the Governor, one by the Speaker of the House, and one by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. Each member would serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority.

The measure also gives the Governor appointing authority over the Executive Director of the Commission, with advice and consent of the Senate. The Executive Director would serve at the pleasure of the Governor, but may be removed from office by a two-thirds vote of each chamber of the Legislature.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies the appointment and removal procedures, and certain job duties and qualifications, for members of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission. Further, the measure as written, grants the Governor the ability to appoint the Executive Director, and establish the position's salary, to this non-appropriated agency. The language of the measure indicates no anticipated fiscal impact.
