## **Research Analysis**

The CS to HB 4118 sets the minimum hours of continuing education required for physical therapist and physical therapist assistant licensure renewals. Physical therapists must meet a minimum of 40 hours of continuing education every two years and physical therapists must meet a minimum of 20 hours every two years. The Oklahoma Medical Board may not require that his continuing education requirement be fulfilled through live courses. If a licensee fails to complete the continuing education hours requirement, the board may fine up to \$50 or suspend the license temporarily.
