Research Analysis

The committee amendment to HB 4118 states that no continuing education requirement for physical therapist licensure must be required through live courses. Further, the amendment clarifies the minimum hours required for continuing education to be 40 hours every two years for physical therapists and 20 hours every two years for physical therapist assistants. Lastly, the amendment adds that if a licensee fails to complete the continuing education hours requirement, the Oklahoma Medical Board may fine up to \$50 or suspend the license temporarily.
