**Research Analysis**

HB 4133, as introduced, makes changes to the list of immunizations a child must receive before they can be admitted into any school in the state.

The measure requires children to have received, or be in the process of receiving, the vaccines required by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

HB 4133 eliminates the mandate that the State Board of Health only alter the list of required immunizations after notice and hearing, and directs any change in the list of required immunizations be in accordance with any change to the list of recommended vaccines by the ACIP.
