**Research Analysis**

SB 1012 removes the exemption for service contract providers who sell vehicle protection products from the requirements of the Service Warranty Act. The measure expands “vehicle protection product” to include protective chemical systems. Further, the measure removes services provided under the terms of an ancillary protection products from the definition of “motor vehicle ancillary service”. The measure removes repair of interior surfaces or repair of exterior paint to be included in motor vehicle ancillary services. The measure removes “motor vehicle ancillary protection product”.
