**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides authorization to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to employ funds from the health Employee and Economy Improvement Act (HEEIA) Revolving Fund to fund the state share for the Oklahoma Medicaid program. Fund revenue to date in FY-20 totals \$64,138,362. Fund revenue sources include portions of the cigarette and tobacco products taxes.
