The committee substitute to SB 113 allows a Retail Wine License, a Retail Beer License, or a Mixed Beverage License holder to sell beer or wine on credit when the holder of such license is a private membership club, marina, golf course or country club that normally charges food, drinks and other purchases to the member's monthly dues account in the regular course of business.
