## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB122 strikes language that requires state agencies to submit office expansion plans to the State Governmental Technology Review Board for review. The measure also requires state agencies to submit telework documentation to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services any time an agency intends to lease or acquire real property. Current law defines telework as work which is performed outside of the traditional on-site work environment.
