Research Analysis

SB 1274 repeals all sections of the Fuel Alcohol Act, Title 2 Sections 11-20 through 11-27, which prohibit production of alcohol for use as a motor fuel without permits from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and from the State Department of Agriculture. The repealed sections include:

- § 11-20. Short Title
- § 11-21. Permit Required
- § 11-22. Kinds of Permits - Fees – Rules
- § 11-23. Application for Permit - Display of Permit
- § 11-24. Revocation of Permit
- § 11-25. List of Registered Alcohol Producers
- § 11-26. Violations – Penalties
- § 11-27. Rules - Inspection of Plants
