**Research Analysis**

SB 1290 makes it a felony to assault any medical provider. Those convicted of assaulting a medical provider will be imprisoned for a term between two to five years. Health facilities are directed to display a sign notifying individuals of the crime and to report annually to the State Department of Health on assaults.
