**Research Analysis**

SB 1370 creates the Indian Health Services, Tribal, and Urban Indian (I/T/U) Shared Savings Program within the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). The program allows for services provided by a non-tribal provider to an American Indian or Alaska Native (AI/AN) beneficiary as a result of an I/T/U referral to be reimbursed at the enhanced federal matching rate of 100%. The Authority is directed to disburse up to 50% of savings resulting from the program to participating I/T/U facilities, after administrative costs have been covered. Remaining savings are to be allocated to the newly created I/T/U Shared Savings Revolving Fund, which will be used for increasing Medicaid provider reimbursement rates. OHCA is directed to promulgate rules and to seek federal approval for the program.
