**Research Analysis**

SB 148 establishes enrollment periods for virtual charter schools. Students enrolling in virtual charter schools must do so between June 1 – September 15, or December 20 – January 30. A student may enroll in a virtual charter school outside of these enrollment periods if they meet one of the emergency exceptions. The measure also establishes criteria under which a student may withdraw from a statewide virtual charter school and transfer to a public school district.
