Research Analysis

SB 1559 clarifies education requirements for members of a county board of equalization or a county excise board. A member would be required to complete a course of instruction consisting of at least six hours on the duties imposed on the board. The deadline to complete the course is shortened from 18 months to 12. The measure also requires an annual continuing education course of at least three hours.

The bill increases compensation to a member of a county board of equalization, from \$50 to \$100 in smaller counties and from \$75 to \$125 in larger counties.

Finally, SB 1559 imposes an attendance requirement on members of a county board of equalization or a county excise board. Members who miss more than three meeting days per calendar year without excusal forfeit their office.
