**Research Analysis**

SB 1660 allows law enforcement officers to transfer consenting persons in possession of controlled dangerous substances or drug paraphernalia to a drug treatment center, center for substance abuse evaluation, or other facility, in lieu of an arrest. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services may approve or disapprove any treatment center. Political subdivisions are authorized to oversee these programs, provided the program is approved by the county district attorney.
