**Research Analysis**

CCR A to SB 170 creates the following license plates: Combat Action Badge Recipient, Iraq Combat Veteran, Afghanistan Combat Veteran, Special Forces Association, Toastmasters International, Millwood High School Alumni, Patriot Guard Riders, Bixby School District, Monarch Butterfly, Oklahoma Tennis Foundation, Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization, FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology), Historic Greenwood District, and Pittsburg State University. The existing Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran, Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran and Folds of Honor Supporter license plates would be made available for motorcycles.

The bill replaces the current Veterans of Foreign Wars license plate with one to be designed in consultation with the VFW Foundation, and authorizes the Tax Commission to enter into an agreement with the foundation for any licensing fees required.

Finally, the measure creates the Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund consisting of monies received by the Department of Commerce from Historic Greenwood District license plates. Monies in the fund are to be used to support and promote Historic Greenwood's Juneteenth Festival.
