## **Research Analysis**

SB 170 creates the following license plates: Combat Action Badge Recipient, Iraq Combat Veterans, Afghanistan Combat Veterans, Toastmasters International, Millwood High School Alumni, Patriot Guard Riders, Bixby School District, Monarch Butterfly, Oklahoma Tennis Foundation, Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization, FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology), Historic Greenwood District, Folds of Honor, and Pittsburg State University. The existing Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran and Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plates would be made available for motorcycles.

The bill replaces the current Veterans of Foreign Wars license plate with one to be designed in consultation with the VFW Foundation, and authorizes the Tax Commission to enter into an agreement with the foundation for any licensing fees required. Finally, the measure creates a revolving fund for monies received for Monarch Butterfly license plates, to be used by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission for grants to fund the Nature Conservancy's operations.
