## **Research Analysis**

SB 171 directs CLEET to recognize military police who have completed training as identified in the Department of Defense POST Instruction 5525.1 Guideline 1 and who have served in a full-time military police capacity for six months within the preceding two years of full-time employment as an Oklahoma Law Enforcement Officer and who have retired or been honorably discharged from military service. Military police who meet this standard are required to attend the three-hundred-sixty hour basic full-time academy to be certified as a full-time peace officer.
