Research Analysis

SB 1859 modifies the Heartbeat Informed Consent Act, requiring that if a pregnant woman seeking an abortion is at least six weeks pregnant, a provider must to determine the presence of a fetal heartbeat or brain function. The provider must record the results of the test detecting heartbeat or brain function and may not induce an abortion if the provider detects presence of either. Providers violating this prohibition may have their license revoked.
