FA4 to SB 186 excludes defendants with prior felony convictions who enter pleas of guilty or nolo contendere to nonviolent felony offenses and defendants who enter pleas of not guilty to a nonviolent felony offense and are found guilty by a non-jury trial from having to pay the \$500 presentence fee.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FA4 on SB 186 excludes defendants with prior felony convictions who enter pleas of guilty or nolo contendere to nonviolent felony offenses and defendants who enter pleas of not guilty to a nonviolent felony offense and are found guilty by a non-jury trial from having to pay the \$500 presentence fee. This could reduce the amount of fees paid by defendants and reduce the revenue for the Department of Corrections (DOC). The ultimate impact is contingent upon how many defendants are excluded from the fee.
