**Research Analysis**

SB 19 provides that secondary proof of identity is only required for REAL ID non-compliant driver license or identification cards. The measure requires persons applying for a REAL ID compliant driver license or identification card to provide proof of principal residency. The Department of Public Safety is to promulgate rules regarding proof of residency. The measure requires driver licenses or identification cards issued by the Department to only bear residential addresses.
