**Fiscal Analysis**

The FA1 on SB 19 creates an automatic voter registration system. According to the State Election Board:

*On short notice it is not possible to develop an accurate estimate of a fiscal impact for the creation of an automatic voter registration system. However, there would likely be significant costs to both the State Election Board and the Department of Public Safety (DPS).*

*Developing a fiscal impact estimate is further complicated because the amendment does not provide procedures for an automatic voter registration system, and it appears to conflict with the requirements of Title 26, Section 4-109.3, which provides the current procedure for voter registration services provided by motor license agents.*

Ultimately the impact is dependent on the system developed by the Election Board and DPS.
