**Research Analysis**

SB 1937 strikes language requiring that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) utilize the Rate Preservation Fund solely to maintain provider reimbursement rates in the event the state's Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) decreases. The measure allows OHCA to use the Rate Preservation Fund more broadly to maintain provider reimbursement rates.
