**Research Analysis**

SB 201 adds a definition of “personal degradation” to the Protective Services for Vulnerable Adults Act, to mean a willful act or statement by a caretaker intended to humiliate or harm the personal dignity of a vulnerable adult, or where the caretaker knew or reasonably should have known the act or statement would humiliate or harm the dignity of the adult.
