**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB245 clarifies an exemption to the provision of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act. The measure provides that actions or transactions done by retailers or other persons acting in good faith on the basis of information or matter supplied by others and without knowledge of the deceptive character of such information or matter is exempt from the act regardless of whether or not the business performing such acts is regulated by any state entity.
