SB 249 provides that all funds received by a drug court, in its capacity as a drug court, are to be credited to and accounted for in the county treasurer's office in a special cash fund to be known as the "Drug Court Fund".

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 249 creates a "Drug Court Fund" for each county drug court. Funds can only be expended upon sworn itemized claims approved by the judge of the respective drug court or another designated member of the drug court team, filed with the county treasurer and paid by cash voucher.
