**Research Analysis**

The PCS for SB 279 directs the Governor to fill a vacancy occurring in the office of a member of the U. S. Senate from Oklahoma within 30 days and to call a special election to fill the seat, unless it is in an even-numbered year and the term of the office expires in January of the following year. The person appointed to fill the vacancy will be ineligible to run for the office at special election. Finally, the bill includes a non-severability clause.
