Research Analysis

SB 319 requires any law enforcement agency seizing property under the asset forfeiture laws to submit an annual report by February 1 each year to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, the Chair of the House and Senate Public Safety Committee and the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector which identifies the property seized and the disposition of the property. The report is to be available for public inspection.
