## **Research Analysis**

SB 347 provides an exemption to the requirement for persons holding a commercial class A license to obtain a hazardous materials endorsement if the person is acting within the scope of their employment at a custom harvester operation, agrichemical business, farm retail outlet and supplier, livestock feeder or is operating a service vehicle transporting diesel fuel of 1,000 gallons or less, and clearly marked with a "flammable" or "combustible" placard as appropriate.
