## **Research Analysis**

SB 378 allows any public or private commercial driving school that has or maintains a program instructing students for a Class A, B, or C license operating under the State Board of Career and Technology Education to hire or employ designated examiners of the Department of Public Safety to be third-party testers of the Class A, B or C driving skills portion of the Oklahoma driving examination. DPS is to adopt a curriculum of required courses and training to be offered to third-party testers and is to conduct annual nationwide criminal history background check on each third-party tester.
