SB430 authorizes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) to conduct and receive results of national criminal history record checks for authorized purposes pursuant to the National Child Protection Act/Volunteers for Children Act. SB430 mandates the results of the record checks can only be shared with entities authorized to receive the results pursuant to federal law.
