Research Analysis

SB441 requires schools to be in session no fewer than 1,080 hours through the 2019-2020 school year.

Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, schools are required to be in session no less than 1,080 hours, and no fewer than 165 days each year.

Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, a school district may go fewer than 165 days a year if the district meets minimum guidelines for student performance and school district cost savings established by the State Board of Education. The school must still be in session for at least 1,080 hours.

The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules establishing the minimum guidelines for student performance and cost savings.
