Impact:	Authorizes the creation of a fee for the non-appropriated Oklahoma Bar Association

Research Analysis

SB 514 creates a reciprocal license process to practice law in this state. The measure outlines the requirements for a person to apply for approval to practice law in the state and requires applicants to pay fines and fees currently set by the Oklahoma Supreme Court. If the applicant's original state maintains stricter standards and higher fees than Oklahoma, the applicant will be required to comply with the same rules and fees that would apply to an applicant from this state seeking admission to the bar in the state or territory from which the applicant is claiming reciprocity.

SB 514 authorizes the creation of a fee for a reciprocal licenses. 100% of this revenue will go to the Oklahoma Bar Association: a non-appropriated state entity. No fiscal impact for the state is anticipated.
