## **Research Analysis**

The CCR A to SB 532 recedes from the House amendments and return the bill to the engrossed version.

SB 532 authorizes secured parties that meet the requirements for licensure for dispensaries, growers, and processors to continue operations of a dispensary, grower, or processor which ceases operations. The receiver must submit proof to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority that the requirements for licensure are met before continuing operations. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority is directed to promulgate rules related to the disposal of marijuana items and the continuing operations by the receiver.
