## **Research Analysis**

SB 532 authorizes secured parties that meet the requirements for licensure for dispensaries, growers, and processors to continue operations of a dispensary, grower, or processor which ceases operations. The receiver must submit proof to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority the requirements for licensure are met before continuing operations. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority is directed to promulgate rules related to the disposal of marijuana items, the business license of the closed entity, and the continuing operations by the receiver. The measure also allows a publicly traded company to obtain a medical marijuana business license.
