**Research Analysis**

SB575 requires school districts obtain parental consent before medical professionals can treat and evaluate students. The measure requires the parental consent be effective for one year and renewed each subsequent year.

Once school districts obtain consent for the year, a medical professional performing evaluation or treatment through telemedicine is not required to verify the parent is on site.
