Fiscal Analysis

SB 584 requires annual third-party information security audits for state agencies not consolidated under the provisions of the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act. The measure excludes from such requirement Agencies subject to mandatory North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) cybersecurity standards.

Officials from the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES-ISD) provided the following lists of agencies not consolidated under the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act and corresponding information security audit cost estimates. It is assumed that each non-appropriated state agency would be required to absorb the additional costs associated with the information security audits required by SB 584; whereas, appropriated state agencies would receive increased appropriations to cover such costs. For this reason the needed increase in state budget appropriations for SB 584 in its current form is estimated to be \$1,230,000.
