Research Analysis

SB 589 empowers the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police to conduct compliance reviews of local law enforcement agencies relating to certain safety and liability issues, upon receipt of a complaint or reasonable cause to believe the agency has failed to comply. In the case of a failed compliance review, an agency would have six months from receipt of notice of failure to come into compliance. The measure provides that failure to comply would result in the association notifying the chief elected official of the agency's governing body and its liability insurance company.
