## **Research Analysis**

SB593 requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to develop a rubric for implementing quality computer science programs in elementary, middle, and high schools by December 31, 2019.

The measure directs the State Board of Education to allocate one million dollars—subject to legislative appropriations—to develop and implement high quality professional learning opportunities for computer science courses that align with the rubric and the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Computer Science.

SB593 authorizes the SDE to create a grant program for the purpose of providing computer science professional development opportunities to school districts and high-quality computer science professional learning providers, and lists how grant money may be spent.
