**Research Analysis**

SB 609 obligates municipal law enforcement to transport a person initially contacted within their jurisdiction. If a person is initially contacted outside of the bounds of the municipality's jurisdiction, the county sheriff will be responsible for transport. The measure requires a licensed mental health professional to document the location of the initial contact to determine jurisdiction for responsible transporting agency. The measure defines "initially contacted" as contact by law enforcement officers, firefighters, EMTs, or health care providers either in person or via electronic/telephone communication.
