Research Analysis

SB612 requires any person convicted of creating, possessing, or using a counterfeit medical marijuana license to be charged with a misdemeanor and subject to not more than one year in jail or a fine of not more than \$500, or both imprisonment and fine.

The measure also requires any person convicted of intentionally and falsely using another person's medical marijuana license as their own to be charged with a misdemeanor and subject to not more than one year in jail or a fine of not more than \$500, or both imprisonment and fine.
