SB 629 allows the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to set a medication fee for opioid substitution treatment programs for patients who are Medicare or Medicaid recipients. The measure designates the treatment program to set a medication fee for participants in the program who are not Medicaid or Medicare recipients.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 629 allows the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to approve a standard medication fee for persons participating in an opioid substitution treatment program (existing law) for recipients of Medicare and Medicaid. The measure allows a treatment program to assess a medication fee on persons participating in an opioid substitution treatment program who are not recipients of Medicare or Medicaid in an amount determined by the treatment program.
