Research Analysis

SB 636 requires all law enforcement agencies, in collaboration with the county or district attorney in their jurisdiction to adopt a written policy requiring electronic recording of custodial interrogations of individuals suspected of homicide or a felony sex offense. The policy must include a requirement that the electronic recording be the entire interrogation, the making or signing of a statement must be recorded, requirements for retention and storage of the recording, and a statement of exceptions to the requirement for recording.
