**Research Analysis**

SB 670 authorizes active duty military personnel and their spouses to request in advance of transfer request a temporary, reciprocal occupational license for their currently held valid license from another state. The measure directs state agencies, boards, and commissions to verify the applicant has the equivalent training, education, and experience, and if found to be in good standing, to issue the requested license within 30 days of receiving the request. The measure states that the temporary license shall be valid for the same period as a full license. The measure outlines procedures for denial of applications, in which case the applicant will be issued a temporary credential and possess the right to appeal. The measure directs agencies, boards, and commissions to waive any application fee.
