**Research Analysis**

The CS to SB 690 increases the maximum allowable height of any vehicle on Oklahoma turnpikes, interstate highways, state and federal highways from 13.5 feet to 14 feet.

The measure requires The Department of Transportation to provide on its website an official state bridge vertical clearance map providing clearance heights as posted for bridges on the interstate, U.S. and state highway systems. The measure provides that operators and owners of vehicles which exceed or have loads which exceed 13.5 feet are to be held liable for all damages to any part of structures spanning the highway or damages suffered by other affected parties caused by the vehicle or load exceeding the posted height.
