**Research Analysis**

The CS for SB 742 requires school districts to annually submit to the State Department of Education (SDE) a report detailing instances of truancy violations within the district and requires District Attorneys to send a report to SDE detailing the instances of students convicted of truancy. The measure further directs SDE to forward these reports to the Office of Child Abuse Prevention at the State Department of Health for possible assessment of the family's need for services and to give Child Welfare Services access to identifying information and school attendance reports of students with developmental disabilities.
