Research Analysis

SB 744 makes it a delinquent act for a juvenile to make a false report, perpetuate a hoax, or conspire to make a false report concerning an explosive or incendiary device. Upon adjudication, the juvenile will be referred to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs for rehabilitation. The rehabilitation plan will be heard at the dispositional hearing. The court may also suspend the juvenile's license.
