Research Analysis

SB 748 transfers the powers and duties of the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) and the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to the State Board of Education, effective July 1, 2020.

All buildings, personnel, funds, and liabilities held by the Commission and Office will be transferred to the State Department of Education. Rules enforced by the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability that are in effect by July 1, 2020, will be carried over under the consolidation until the State Board promulgates new rules.

The measure also repeals the sections of law that created the OEQA, the sections of law that outline the duties of the OEQA, and the section of law that establishes the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.
